

Managing dung beetles in a grazing environment



Wednesday 1st December 3-5 pm

Russ Barrow from Charles Sturt University will be in the Bega Valley next week and will join us for an information session on dung beetles in our grazing environment.

Russ is the Technical Research Coordinator for the Dung Beetle Ecosystem Engineers project which is expanding the range of dung beetles in Australia and analysing their performance for livestock producers.

Russ will discuss the trial release of a new species of dung beetle in the Cobargo area and monitoring work that has been done to look at the impacts of fire on dung beetle populations. We will also kick a few cow pats and see what dung beetle activity is occurring on the property.
